

## **Manley Weston Allen**

Manley Weston Allen was born 27 January 1899 in St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minnesota. His parents were Ambrose John and Anna (Plummer) Allen, and Manley was their seventh child. Ambrose Allen was a cattle buyer. Manley W. Allen enlisted in the Navy on 26 July 1918 while a resident of West St. Paul, Dakota County, Minnesota.

During WWI, Allen served until 17 January 1919 in the Radio Department at the Great Lakes Training Station.

Manley Weston Allen was married to Caroline Stopf (1896-1992). He worked for the Department of Education at the Ramsey County Court House when he registered for the draft in WWII. He died 23 January 1981 at age 81 and is buried at Fort Snelling National Cemetery in Minneapolis alongside his wife.
