

Arthur Alvin Hahn

Arthur Hahn was born on February 15th, 1898, in Jordan, Minnesota, to John and Minna Hahn. Both of his parents were born in Germany. Arthur enlisted into the Navy on January 8th, 1918, and served as a First Petty Officer or Quarter Master 3. He was discharged on September 9th, 1919.

After his service in the Navy, Arthur lived with his sister Anna Roberge and her husband, Albert Roberge. Their father, John, also lived there. Arthur worked as a laborer for a contractor. According to the 1930 US Census, Arthur was married to his wife Elle with three children Marion, Robert, and Patricia. They lived in Minneapolis, where he worked as an office manager in the money loan industry. Ten years later, he worked as an accountant for the Sanitation Department for the City of Minneapolis. Arthur died on May 5th, 1957, at the age of 59. He is buried in Fort Snelling National Cemetery.
